of God. If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness (1 John 1:8-9). And we have seen and do testify that the Father sent the Son to be the Savior of the world. Whosoever shall confess that Jesus is the Son of God, God dwelleth in him, and he in God (1 John 4:14-15).

Only Jesus Christ can save us. We can find salvation in no one else. Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me (John 14:6). Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved (Acts 4:12). Sirs, what must I do to be saved? And they said, Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and thou shalt be saved (Acts 16:30b-31a).

Salvation and eternal life are a free gift. For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: Not of works, lest any man should boast (Ephesians 2:8-9).

And once we have received this free gift of God's grace, nothing can ever take it away from us. For I am persuaded, that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come, nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord (Romans 8:38-39). For the gifts and calling of God are without repentance (Romans 11:29). For he hath said, I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee (Hebrews 13:5b). And, lo, I am with you always, even unto the end of the world. Amen (Matthew 28:20b).

It is our hope and prayer that you will seriously consider what you have read. None of us can know when the day of our death will come. You may live for many more years, or your life on this earth could end tomorrow. Once we depart from this life, it is too late to repent. And as it is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgment (Hebrews 9:27). Now is the time to turn from our unbelief and accept Jesus Christ as our Lord and Savior. For he saith, I have heard thee in a time accepted, and in the day of salvation have I succored thee: behold, now is the accepted time; behold, now is the day of salvation (2 Corinthians 6:2).

The May of Eternal Life



The message of this pamphlet is dedicated to all those who do not know Jesus Christ. The Bible, which is the Word of God, declares that without Him, we are without hope and without eternal life.

The Holy Scriptures teach us that all men need a Savior, because we are all lost and dead in our sins, and separated from God. There is none righteous, no not one (Romans 3:10). For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God (Romans 3:23). As sinners, we cannot save ourselves. Our own works can never take away our sins and make us good enough for Heaven. Knowing that a man is not justified by the works of the law, but by the faith of Jesus Christ, even we have believed in Jesus Christ, that we might be justified by the faith of Christ, and not by the works of the law: for by the works of the law shall no flesh be justified (Galatians 2:16).

God in His love and grace has provided the answer to our lost, hopeless condition. He sent His Son to die in our place. God became a man. For God sent not his Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through him might be saved. He that believeth on him is not condemned: but he that believeth not is condemned already, because he hath not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God (John 3:17-18). And without controversy great is the mystery of godliness: God was manifest in the flesh, justified in the Spirit, seen of angels, preached unto the Gentiles, believed on in the world, received up into glory (1 Timothy 3:16).

The Lord Jesus was born into this world to die for the sins of all mankind. And He accomplished His purpose. And the angel said unto them, Fear not: for, behold, I bring you

good tidings of great joy, which shall be to all people. For unto you is born this day in the city of David a Savior, which is Christ the Lord (Luke 2:10-11). For the Son of man is come to save that which was lost (Matthew 18:11).

Jesus Christ paid the penalty of sin for the ungodly and unrighteous, so that we could become righteous and justified before God, with our sins washed away forever. For he hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him (2 Corinthians 5:21). And from Jesus Christ, who is the faithful witness, and the first begotten of the dead, and the prince of the kings of the earth. Unto him that loved us, and washed us from our sins in his own blood (Revelation 1:5). For when we were yet without strength, in due time Christ died for the ungodly (Romans 5:6). Come now, and let us reason together, saith the LORD: though your sins be as scarlet, they shall be as white as snow; though they be red like crimson, they shall be as wool (Isaiah 1:18). As far as the east is from the west, so far hath he removed our transgressions from us (Psalm 103:12).

The Lord Jesus went to the Cross and suffered and died for us all. He paid the debt of our sins as our substitute. He won the ultimate victory over sin and death, and He rose again. O death, where is thy sting? O grave, where is thy victory? The sting of death is sin; and the strength of sin is the law. But thanks be to God, which giveth us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ (1 Corinthians 15:55-57). For I delivered unto you first of all that which I also received, how that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures; And that he was buried, and that he rose again the third day according to the Scriptures (1 Corin-

thians 15:3-4).

If we accept God's offer of forgiveness and believe in Jesus Christ, we are saved from God's judgment and have a glorious future in His kingdom. As saved sinners, we can now eagerly await the future return of our Lord Jesus Christ. Looking for that blessed hope, and the glorious appearing of the great God and our Savior Jesus Christ (Titus 2:13). ... Waiting for the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ: who shall also confirm you unto the end, that ye may be blameless in the day of our Lord Jesus Christ (1 Corinthians 1:7b-8).

But His return will be a fearful day for those who reject him. Men's hearts failing them for fear, and for looking after those things which are coming on the earth: for the powers of heaven shall be shaken. And then shall they see the Son of man coming in a cloud with power and great glory (Luke 21:26 -27). When the Son of man shall come in his glory, and all the holy angels with him, then shall he sit upon the throne of his glory: And before him shall be gathered all nations: and he shall separate them one from another, as a shepherd divideth his sheep from the goats: And he shall set the sheep on his right hand, but the goats on the left. Then shall the King say unto them on his right hand, Come, ye blessed of my Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world... Then shall he say also unto them on the left hand, Depart from me, ye cursed, into everlasting fire, prepared for the devil and his angels (Matthew 25:31-34,41).

There is only one way to be delivered from eternal condemnation. We must all confess our lost, sinful condition, and confess that Jesus Christ is our Savior, the Son
